- Offer follow up help including awareness raising and empowering techniques designed to educate, support and guard against further financial abuse

## ***Friends of the Elderly: Supporting Friends***

We cannot help people living in residential care. Supporting Friends prioritises its grants for people who are not eligible for help from any other trade, professional or Service benevolent fund.
