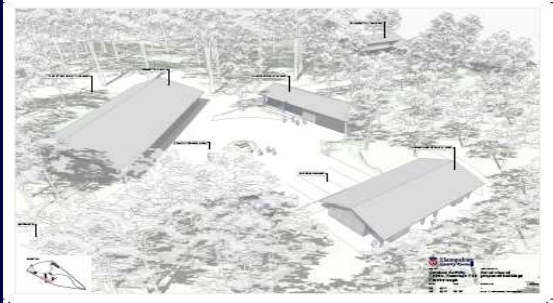


## RUNWAYS END ACTIVITY CENTRE
