Homelessness means not having a home

Some people have no roof over their head and sleep on the street, in doorways or on night buses. But much more homelessness is hidden. Even people with a roof over their head can still be homeless, if they don't have any rights to stay where they live; temporarily staying with friends or family; their home is unsuitable due to severe overcrowding; living in poor conditions that affect your health. You could become homeless for many different reasons: being evicted because of rent arrears caused by money problems; the breakdown of your relationship with your partner, parents or family; having to leave because of domestic violence or abuse; illegal eviction or harassment by a landlord; a disaster such as a fire or flooding.

Part of the role of Rushmoor Voluntary Services is to bring together information, from both voluntary/community organisations and statutory authorities which will benefit the residents and community wellbeing of Rushmoor hence this production of this guide which is ONE OF A SERIES
