Community Information

Rushmoor Voluntary Services is a Registered Charity Number 1059794 and a Company Limited by Guarantee registered in England and Wales Registration Number 3238444

Transport affects everyone. It influences where we live, work, shop, enjoy leisure activities and where our children are educated. It also has a major impact on the environment. Transport providers fall into two different categories: public transport like bus, train, taxi, National Express, ferries, hospital transport; community transport such as Dial-a-Ride, Community Transport Schemes, Voluntary Car Schemes, ShopMobility. Hampshire County Council (HCC) provides free concessionary travel on local buses throughout Hampshire and the rest of England to older residents, or those over five who have specific disabilities. HCC also provides Blue Badges for people with a permanent and substantial disability which causes inability to walk or very considerable difficulty in walking allowing the use of designated parking spaces; in some circumstances parking on single or double yellow lines; free parking at parking meters in some areas. The scheme applies to Blue Badge holders as drivers or when being carried as a passenger

Part of the role of Rushmoor Voluntary Services is to bring together information, from both voluntary/community organisations and statutory authorities which will benefit the residents and community wellbeing of Rushmoor hence this production of this guide which is ONE OF A SERIES

For an annual membership fee of £10 your group can hire our buses. Both buses have 15 seats, but with the removal of some of these, up to 4 fixed wheelchairs can be carried. Eligible groups are those within the Yateley Area, the majority of whose members cannot use public transport, are over 60 or under 16 or are disabled. Our drivers both volunteer and paid are MiDAS and CRB accredited. If you use your own driver they must be similarly qualified. You will be required to provide one person in charge.
