Our Vision & Mission

Yateley Industries works to sustain and increase opportunities for people with disabilities in rewarding employment, both in its internal employment and mainstream work. With an occupation that enables a person with disabilities to contribute to society. It operates one of the few remaining supported factories that help vulnerable adults to do paid meaningful work and training intended to help progress them into mainstream employment.



Yateley Industries also provides a contract packing/assembly service for several local businesses, using specialised packing and cutting machines for shrink wrapping hardware. Other projects have included packing hair care products, assembling vehicle lighting components and small motor parts, bottling glue, labelling CDs and mailshots as well as packing car accessories

What we do



At Yateley Industries, our aim is to encourage each individual to fulfil their own potential, both at home and at work.

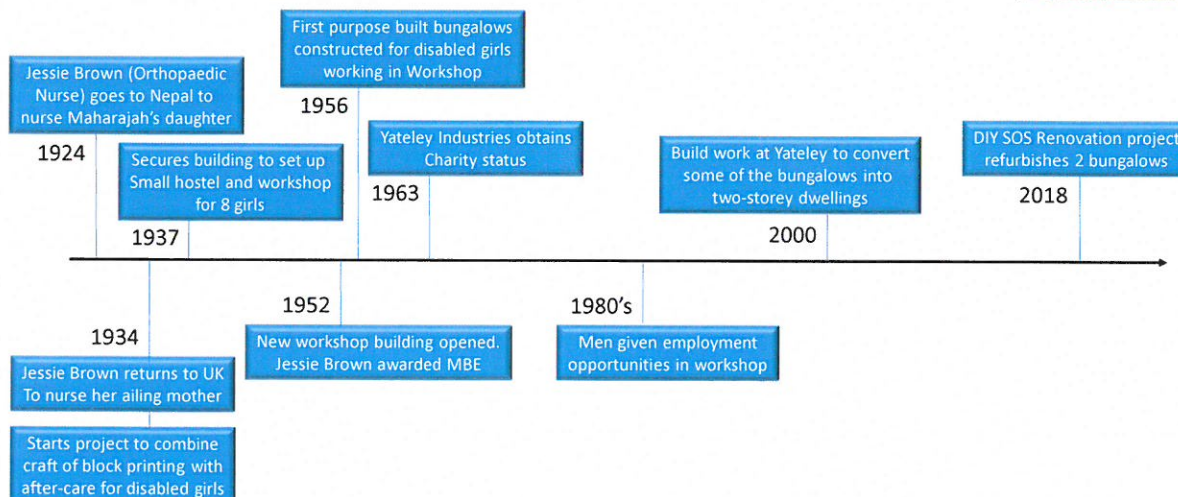
We achieve this by:

- Providing paid, meaningful employment in our supported workshop, and accommodation where required
- Enabling Employees to work towards identified goals, encompassing areas such as financial management, independent living skills, production output and social integration
- Monitoring & recording progress to personal goal achievement, aided by our management team
- Holding regular reviews to provide an opportunity for open discussion of any problems and to clarify aims for the future
- Operating an open door policy for managers/staff, where employees/residents are encouraged to discuss any issues as they arise

Ultimately our aim is to equip our residents and employees with the skills needed to move into "open" employment and independent living

Our Housing & Accommodation



- Yateley Industries three & a half acre site is able to accommodate up to 48 residents
- Our accommodation is adapted for the individual needs of our residents
- In October 2018 we held a "DIY SOS" style project, headed by B&Q, Spie Facilities and their supply chain
- Over a 10 day period, they renovated 2 of our unoccupied residential bungalows that needed modernisation.
- They fitted new bathrooms, kitchens, boiler and fully redecorated the interiors
- Plus they fitted new lighting throughout our factory
- Project costs totalled £45k, yet the companies never asked for a penny
- As a result of the renovations, we can now offer accommodation to 6 new residents who need our help

Our Factory



- Yateley Industries employs over 80 people with disabilities and long term health conditions
- Our operatives work 16 hours per week on a minimum of national minimum wage

Yateley Industries provides high quality packaging for many companies including:

- Firestop
- Chase Hardware
- DKB

Yateley Industries also works in partnership with the Poppy Factory to make:

- Hand made poppies for the British Legion's annual Poppy Appeal
- Yateley has made 15 million hand made poppies in the last 5 years
