Arts, Culture & Heritage



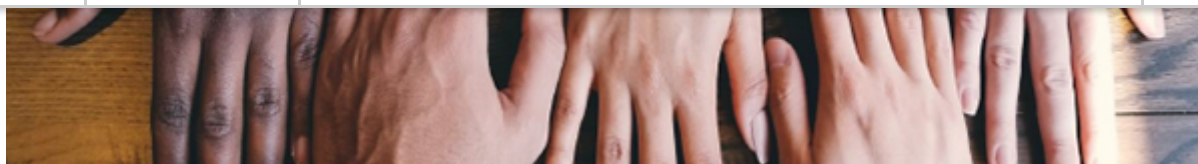
BlueSpark Foundation

The foundation supports the education and development of children and young people by providing grants for educational, cultural, sporting and other projects. The funding is for relatively small-scale projects, which might not happen at all or would only happen on a lesser scale without the support of BlueSpark. Grants of up to £5,000 are available. Historic Houses Foundation

Hospice UK - Extending Frailty Care

This programme invites hospices to think differently and creatively to support high quality care for older people with frailty at end of life. Hubbub - Community Fridge Food Hub Fund

For non-profit organisations with an open community fridge to develop additional 'food hub' activities across the UK. The fund wants to increase the social and environmental impact of community fridges by allowing them to deliver their own activities that will bring local people together and provide access to healthy, affordable and sustainable food. Each successful applicant will receive a grant of £6,000. The fund is open until 23.59 on 7th November 2022. Please [CLICK HERE](#) for more.

COSARAF - Hardship Grants

Grants are available for third party social organisations to support individuals and families across the UK who are in financial need and have exhausted all other sources of funding. It aims to support individuals and families who are struggling with everyday costs, such as basic living expenses, household items and utilities, or rent arrears. Please [CLICK HERE](#) for more.

Church Urban Fund - Refugee Support Small Grants

Grants are available to churches and registered Christian charities to support their outreach work with Ukrainian and Afghan refugees in England. Marsh Commercial - For the People Awards

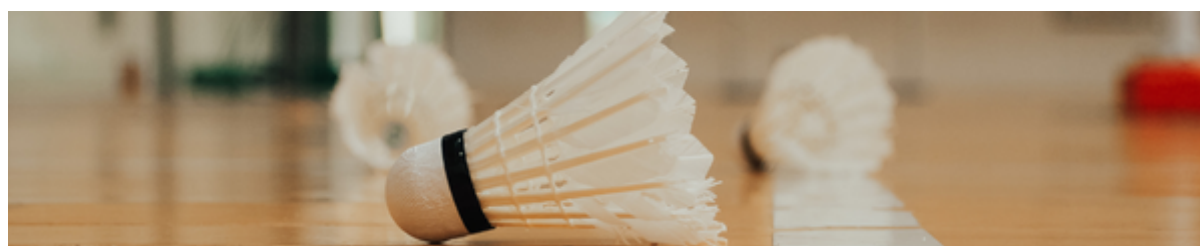
In 2022, the following awards will be made:
