Local Authority

Eastleigh Sport and Talented Athlete Grant

Music for All - Community Project Funding

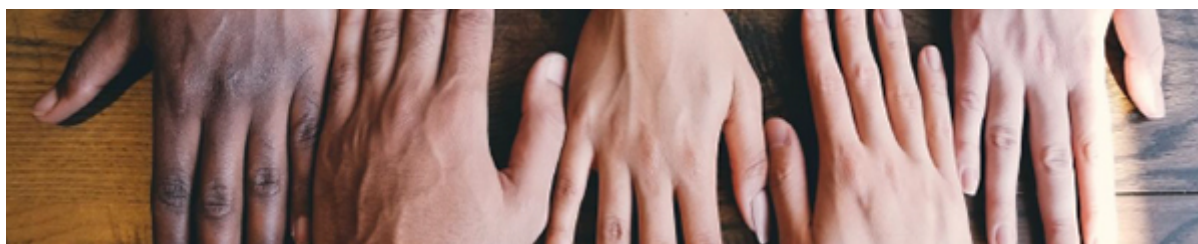

Smaller arts or learning charities with a turnover under £150,000 per annum may be more suitable for consideration under the Foundation's Small Grants Scheme. 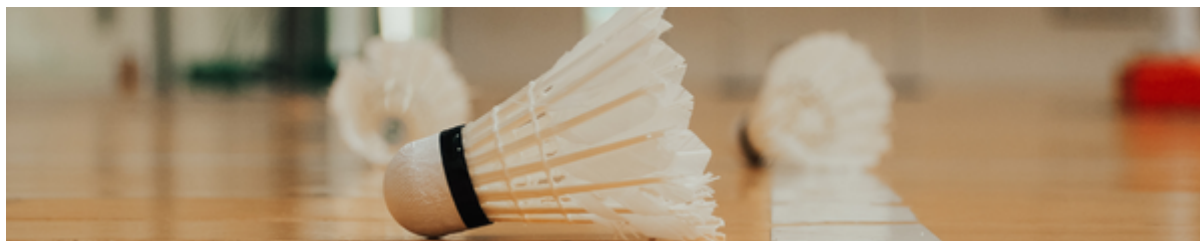
Bishop of Guildford's Communities Fund
