##### **Winchester Council - Project Grants**

Funding is available to support groups with the cost of running existing or new projects which help to deliver sustainable and resilient communities across Winchester. Grants of up to £5,000 are available. Applicants are required to secure at least 25% match funding. Closing date is 7th July, 2023. Please [CLICK HERE](#) to find out more.

##### **Winchester - Rural England Prosperity Fund**

Grants are available to support rural businesses and community infrastructure, helping to improve productivity and strengthen the rural economy and rural communities in Winchester, as part of the Rural England Prosperity Fund programme. 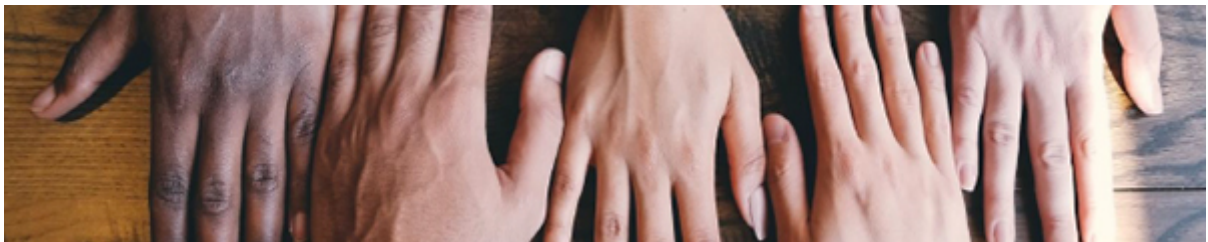
### **PRS Foundation - Open Fund for Organisations**

The Open Fund for Organisations offers grants to promoters, large performance groups, talent development organisations, venues, festivals and curators that promote and encourage new music. It offers grants of up to £10,000. The deadline for application is the 10th July, 2023. Please [CLICK HERE](#) to find out more.

### **Friends of Friendless Churches - The Cottam Will Trust**

Funding is intended to be used for the purchase of works of art to be placed in medieval churches. Grants can be made for items such as: statues, murals, paintings, Paschal candlesticks, vestments, Commandment Boards, stained glass, altars and altar frontals. ## **Health & Social Welfare**



### **Armed Forces Covenant Fund Trust - Force for Change Programme**

The funding aims to support community projects that reduce isolation and promote integration and is offered to registered charities and CICs with substantial recent experience of supporting Armed Forces communities. In 2023, the programme will support ideas that need small amounts of funding to deliver changes or improvements for those communities. Grants of up to £15,000 over one-year are available. ### **Lloyds Bank Foundation - d/Deaf and Disabled People's Organisations**

Unrestricted grants are available for local registered charities and charitable incorporated organisations which are led by and working for d/Deaf and disabled people who are experiencing poverty in England and Wales. Successful applicants will receive grants of £75,000, over three years (£25,000 per year). The deadline for applications is 31 August 2023. Please [CLICK HERE](#) to find out more.

### **Boshier-Hinton Foundation**

The Boshier-Hinton Foundation exists to improve quality of life for people with disabilities, learning difficulties or sensory impairment and their families, by the awarding of grants to organisations providing facilities and advocacy for children and adults with special educational or other needs. ### **Bupa Foundation Green Community Grants**

The funding is intended for practical projects. Priority will be given to the regeneration of green spaces for community use, however other project ideas are welcome. ### **Biffa Award Main Grants Scheme – Rebuilding Biodiversity**

The Biffa Award Rebuilding Biodiversity theme provides grants for conservation projects located within 15 miles of a significant Biffa Group Ltd operation or within 10 miles of a landfill site, with the aim of protecting and enhancing the environment so that it can adapt to threats such as climate change. Grants of £10,000 to £75,000 are available. The total cost of the project must be less than £200,000 including VAT. Please [CLICK HERE](#) to find out more.

The funding can support the needs of children and young people who have experienced a crisis that has recently had a significant and enduring impact to their social and emotional wellbeing and their educational engagement. One-off grants are available to registered charities in the UK for projects that enable communities to achieve their full potential by tackling specific issues, helping groups become more efficient and effective, and getting young people and those often excluded involved for the benefit of their community. ### England and Wales Cricket Board - County Grants Fund

Clubs may apply for up to one grant per ECB budget year (1 February to 31 January) but will not be able to apply for a second grant for the same project before 2025.
